2026 CODE OF CONDUCT

Participation in LSOD-SDC is subject to the observance of the program rules.

- Show respect for, and cooperation with, fellow campers, volunteers and staff (Dance Camp & Watson Woods).
- Treat all property with respect. Repair costs for damage incurred to property will be billed to those responsible. Theft or vandalism is prohibited.
- Follow LSOD-SDC policies & procedures when participating and/or teaching a class, involved in an activity, or an event at the Retreat Site, Watson Woods main lodge and recreational activities areas.
- Be responsible for your own belongs, LSOD-SDC is not responsible for any lost or missing items.
- Camp is a safe place for everyone. There is no tolerance for bad behavior, bullying, harassment, or unkindness to any individual. If such behavior occurs it will result in removal from the camp.
- No controlled substances or dangerous materials are permitted on the property.
- Cells phones have become today's camera and music vessel. They are required to be with staff, volunteer/chaperones, medical, instructor and certain counselor positions.
- Counselors & Campers are required, at check in to inform us of all electronic devices they have brought with them. Cabin chaperones will establish usage rules for their cabin.
- Campers are not allowed to go anywhere without permission from a camp staff member and if given permission must go with their camp buddy or a staff team member.
- Respect & observe camp cabin quiet hours: 10:00 pm – 8:00 am. Individuals should be in their designated cabins by 10:00 pm, unless a camp staff member has given them permission to be in another area.

Any participant who knowingly violates this code of conduct is subject to discipline, up to and including removal from the activity he or she is participating in or the entire camp (at his/her own expense).

Determination of disciplinary action shall be done with input from the staff overseeing the program or activity. Parents will be notified to meet & discuss any issues. The final decision about discipline action will be made by the Camp Manager.
